The Lancaster Mennonite Historical Society will conduct its 214th auction on June 8, 2007, at 2215 Millstream Road, Lancaster, Pennsylvania, one-half mile east of the intersection of Routes 30 and 462. The remaining 2007 sales will be held on September 7 and December 7. The auction not only specializes in local and denominational history and genealogy of southeastern Pennsylvania, but also includes theological works and other types of material of interest to the nationwide constituency.
