The Lancaster Mennonite Historical Society will conduct a rare and out-of-print book auction on Sept. 7, 2007, at 2215 Millstream Road, Lancaster, PA, one-half mile east of the intersection of Routes 30 and 462. The auction not only specializes in local and denominational history and genealogy of southeastern Pennsylvania, but also includes theological works and other types of material of interest to the nationwide constituency.
