The Lancaster Mennonite Historical Society will conduct an auction on March 14, 2008, at 2215 Millstream Road, Lancaster, PA, one-half mile east of the intersection of Routes 30 and 462. The remaining sales of this year will be held on April 18, June 13, September 12 and December 12. The auction not only specializes in local and denominational history and genealogy of southeastern Pennsylvania, but also includes theological works and other types of material of interest to the nationwide constituency.
